We will communicate acceptance decisions in late April 2022. If your paper is accepted, you will need to send the complete manuscript to your discussant no later than June 17.

We will convey information on the registration, the preliminary program, and accommodation in early May 2022.

If the conference can be held offline, the attendance fee will be €150 (€80 for PhD candidates), which includes the conference dinner on July 7. We reserve the right not to refund the fee should you later have to cancel.

The annual assembly of the members of GLEA will take place during the conference.
